Campus Size: The beautifully landscaped, self-contained 11-acre (4 hectares) campus was ranked the third-safest campus in the nation and the safest in New York City.

Location: The campus is right in the heart of Brooklyn-located just steps away from the new Barclays Center (sports and entertainment center), top arts venues such as Brooklyn Academy of Music (BAM); the hip restaurants, boutiques and cafes of Fort Greene and 10 minutes from Manhattan via 11 subway lines.

Campus Life: LIU Brooklyn is made up of a number of traditional and ultra-modern buildings that are connected together by a series of enclosed bridges. Students enjoy access to the 112,000 square-foot Steinberg Wellness Center which features tennis courts, a running track, an eight-lane swimming pool, a therapy pool, two weight rooms, an aerobic room and a 17,000 square-foot basketball arena. Students also like to relax in the park-like setting surrounding the Kumble Theater and the Humanities Art Gallery located in the center of the campus. Other key facilities include a four-story library, various student lounges, the Cyber Café and the historic Luntey Commons, part of the former Brooklyn Paramount Theater.
